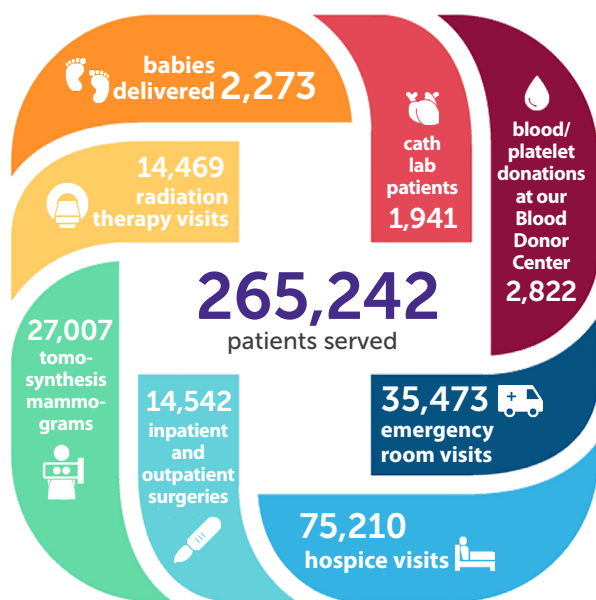

The Beauty In Grace women's giving circle funded screening units that test for jaundice on a baby's skin surface instead of pricking the skin.

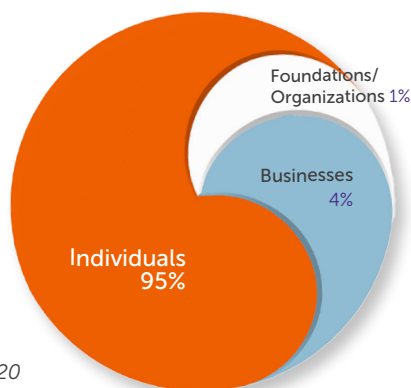
