His passion for his work inspired my own journey—from volunteering at Camp Summersault and in the Child Life Department, to shadowing the hematology-oncology team during my pre-med years. These experiences helped shape my path toward becoming a psychiatrist and deepened my connection to this hospital and community.

Philanthropy has always been a part of my life. My sister and I grew up watching our parents give their time, energy, and resources to support others—whether it was family, friends, or the broader community. We were proud to be involved in the growth of the Jonathan Jaques Children's Cancer Institute, where our dad served as founding medical director. Some of my favorite memories include joining him for the annual Torch Run and participating in the Tour of Long Beach cycling fundraiser to raise funds for the hospital. Those experiences taught me that giving back isn't just something you do—it's a way of life.



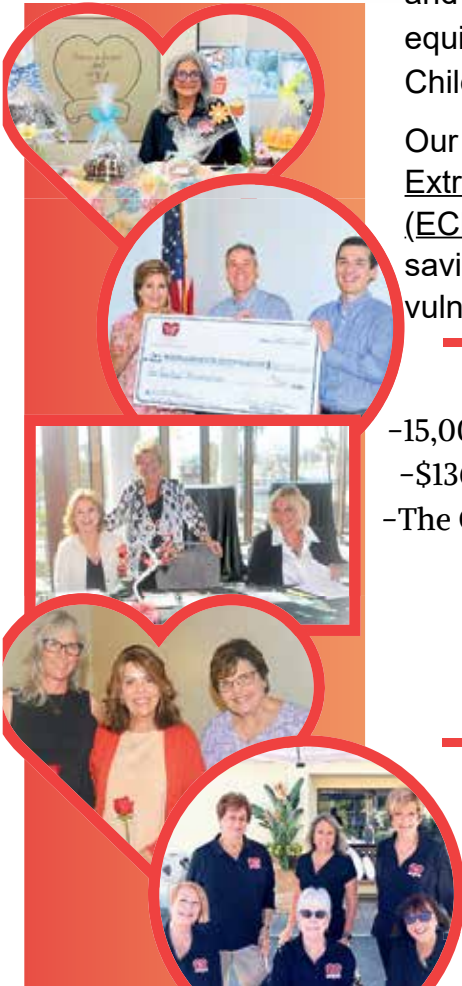
